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THINGS TO CONSIDER IN DOING A GOOD INTERNSHIP IN LIS

1 Think big choose the small
Small organizations tend to value the ideas of students, more than bigger ones.

2 Make sure you are not replacing a position needed
The student should not be recruited by replacing a professional position in order to avoid costs.

3 Help the Information Unit UI in being realistic

4 In a fortnight write a one page report in order to show progress
Generally, organizations think you can do in a semester what takes a year

5 Use a project development approach
Even if you are doing a set of activities, keep in mind the project's goal.

6 Avoid internship places without any LIS professional as part of the staff.
The organization has to be capable in providing a professional available in order to guide the student.

7 Choose a place different than your work place
Your work place can be an opportunity but less demanding than other IU.

8 Choose challenging and unknown areas to learn more
Choose areas that demand a further study on your part.

9 When you have finished, give a complete report of your results, achievements and obstacles
You can leave a good impression if you provide a professional report with aspects to work for.

10 Share your experience with others
Document information about your own personal experience.

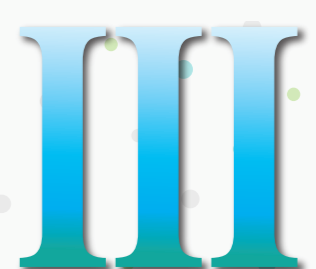
